Years later, Christmas in Englewood evolved into *Christmas in the 8th and 34th Wards*, joined by businessman Everett Rand and working with Aldermen Michelle Harris and Carrie Austin to identify families via community schools with the most profound needs.

Today, as *Christmas in the Wards*, our passion and dedication to uplift the lives of families and students throughout Chicagoland during the holiday season and beyond is realized through incredible partnerships, sponsors, and an engaged board of business, civic, and community leaders. In our twenty-four-year history, we have served 12,000 families from 25 wards across Chicago's south, west, and north side communities.
